
- WARNING! The blades used by this cutter are razor sharp and should be treated with due caution.

- x DO NOT use cutter on hard reinforced pipe. If the blade does not penetrate the pipe, then the materials used to make the pipe are too hard. Applying excessive pressure may cause the pipe to shatter.

2. INTRODUCTION

The PCB35 plastic pipe cutter has a die cast aluminium body with a heat treated AUS-8 grade stainless steel blade. Features ratchet action cutting to avoid the crushing of pipes and push button blade retraction. Suitable for cutting plastic pipes and extrusions. Cutting capacity 6mm to 35mm pipes.


3. OPERATING THE CUTTER

WARNING! Ensure you read, understand and apply safety instructions.




3.1. OPERATING THE CUTTER

3.1.1. Place the plastic pipe into the 'U' jaw with the blade point aligned with the tube centre. Repeatedly squeeze the trigger handle to pierce and cut through the pipe.




3.2. RETRACTING THE BLADE


3.2.1. To retract the blade after cutting squeeze the handles together and press the retraction button as shown at '1' above.







- 3.3.1. Rotate the black spring retaining lever in the handle so that the hook retracts from the spring eyelet thus releasing the spring. (See fig.1-A).
- 3.3.2 Hold the cutter with the head facing downwards so that gravity will assist the blade out. Depress the handle repeatedly to extend the blade as far as possible. (See fig.2-B) Ease the blade outwards until the spring is visible then disconnect the spring using thin nosed pliers. (See fig.2-C) Remove the spring making note of its orientation for reassembly.
- 3.3.3 Slide the blade carefully out of the top of the tool as shown in fia.3-D.
- 3.3.4 Slide the new blade partway into the tool as shown in fig.4-E. With the eyelet flat to the blade, slide the spring into the body of the tool and reconnect the hooked end of the spring into the circular hole in the blade. (See fig.4-F).
- 3.3.5 Depress the trigger handle and retraction button simultaneously and ease the new blade back into the body of the tool. (See fig.4-E)
- 3.3.6 When the spring reappears adjacent to the black spring retaining lever rotate the lever so that the hook re-engages with the spring eyelet.
