




ROUTER TABLE BACK FENCE REF. RT/FENCE

Thank you for purchasing this Trend router table back fence.

These instructions will show you how to assemble the back fence.



Safety Steps

- Always wear eye protection such as goggles, ear protection and use effective respiratory protection.
- Before making adjustments to the router, like changing the cutter, make sure the power is isolated correctly.
 Before re-connecting to the mains
- supply, make sure the power switch on the router is in the 'off' position.
- Do not switch on the router with the cutter in contact with the workpiece.
- Before making adjustments always allow the cutter to stop rotating.
- When routing keep your hands, hair and clothing clear of the cutter.
- Make sure you follow the instructions which came with your router.
- B. Ensure all visors, guards and dust
- extraction are fitted.
- Trial cuts should be made in waste material before starting any project.
- A No-Volt Release Switch should also be fitted to router tables.




