### 1. SAFETY

## 1.1. ELECTRICAL SAFETY

- **WARNING!** It is the user's responsibility to check the following:
- ✓ Check all electrical equipment and appliances to ensure that they are safe before using.
- ✓ Inspect power supply leads, plugs and all electrical connections for wear and damage.
- Ensure that the insulation on all cables and on the appliance is safe before connecting it to the power supply.
- **× DO NOT** use worn or damaged cables, plugs or connectors.
- Ensure that any faulty item is repaired or replaced immediately by a Sealey qualified technician.
- ✓ If the cable or plug is damaged during use, switch off the electricity supply and remove from use.
- If the supply cord is damaged, it must be replaced by the manufacturer, its service agent or similarly qualified persons in order to avoid a hazard.
- ✓ Sealey recommend that an RCD (Residual Current Device) is used with all electrical products.
- Important: Ensure that the voltage rating on the appliance suits the mains power supply.
- **× DO NOT** pull or carry the appliance by the power cable.
- **× DO NOT** pull the plug from the socket by the cable.

#### 1.2. GENERAL SAFETY

- Children from age 8 years and above, persons with reduced physical, sensory, or mental capabilities those with lack of experience and knowledge can use the appliance, if they have been given supervision or instruction concerning use of the appliance in a safe way to understand the hazards involved.
- ✓ Children shall NOT play with the appliance.
- Cleaning and user maintenance on the appliance shall not be made by children without supervision.
- ✓ Disconnect the ventilator from the mains power when not in use, and before servicing or performing any maintenance.
- ✓ Use in dry areas only. **DO NOT** use in wet or high condensation locations such as bathrooms, showers, or pools.
- Always disconnect from the power supply when moving it from one location to another.
- ✓ Keep the ventilator clean and maintain in good condition (use an authorised service agent).
- ✓ Use recommended parts only (unauthorised parts may be dangerous, and will invalidate your warranty).
- **DO NOT** stand the blower where it may be knocked over or off a surface, or where the lead may cause a trip hazard.
- **× DO NOT** use an extension cord unless it has been approved by an electrical authority.
- **× DO NOT** insert any objects through the fan guard.
- **× DO NOT** use outdoors.
- × DO NOT cover.
- ✓ When not in use store in a safe, dry, childproof location.

# 2. INTRODUCTION

Robust, composite housing, carefully balanced with fully guarded blade drum providing quiet and safe operation. Housing design provides three outlet positions from horizontal to vertical, allowing precise direction of airflow for cooling or drying. Handle incorporates cable storage. Suitable for use in industrial, commercial, agricultural and automotive workshops.

# 4. OPERATION

- 4.1. TRANSPORT:
- 4.1.1. Transport and store in product's original packaging to prevent damage.

- WARNING! Ensure you read, understand and apply safety instructions before using the blower. Lift the blower by the handle on the main body and manoeuvre it into desired position. Use in any of the 3 positions illustrated below. Ensure that there isn't anything in front of the blower that may be disturbed when the blower is switched on.
- **4.2.** Check that the switch situated in the recess in the rear grille of the blower is set to "0"/OFF. Uncoil the power lead from its stowage position and plug into the mains power supply. Ensure that the power lead is not stretched or positioned in such a way as to cause a hazard.
- **4.3.** Check that the blower will be stable whilst in operation.
- 4.4. Turn the blower on by switching to "I"/ON. If a greater air flow is required, turn the switch to the "II" or "III" setting (ADB3000 only).
- 4.5. When finished using the blower, ensure the switch is set to the "0"/OFF position and disconnect it from the mains power.
- 4.6. Rewind the lead around the lugs on the carrying handle.
- 4.7. When not in use, place the blower in its original box or otherwise protect it from dust, and store in a safe, dry, childproof location.
- 4.8. OPERATING METHODS IN EVENT OF AN ACCIDENT OR BREAKDOWN
- 4.8.1. Disconnect from mains supply, do not use until fault is rectified.

# 5. MAINTENANCE

- **WARNING!** Ensure the blower is disconnected from the mains power supply before attempting any of the following.
- 5.1. Professional repair only apart from operations listed below.
- 5.2. BEFORE EACH USE:

Check for correct operation, listen for untoward operational noises.

- 5.3. CLEANING
- 5.3.1. Use a soft, slightly dampened cloth to clean the body of the blower. Do not splash with water and never allow water to drip onto the motor housing. **DO NOT** use solvents or other chemicals to clean the blower.
- 5.3.2. If it becomes necessary to clean the blades or the inside of the body, remove the rear grille (the opposite side to the motor) by undoing the retaining screws. Wipe with a slightly damp cloth only. Re-fit the grille and fix in place using the retaining screws.
- 5.3.3. Should the motor, speed control box or the power lead require service or maintenance, contact your local service agent.
- 5.4. STORAGE: Store in a dry place where product will not get dirty or become damaged.

# 6. END OF LIFE

6.1. Dispose of product according to recycling regulations in force.
