1. SAFETY

- □ WARNING! Butane gas is extremely flammable, handle with care.
- **WARNING!** Always point the torch away from the eyes and body when igniting and during operation.
- **WARNING!** Ensure the flame is completely extinguished after use.
- □ WARNING! DO NOT puncture or dispose of in a fire.
- DO NOT use the torch in an area where paint fumes, solvents or other flammable solids, liquids or gases pose a potential hazard. Keep flammable material away from the torch when operating. Flammable waste, such as wiping or cleaning rags, must be placed in a closed metal container and disposed of correctly.
- * DO NOT operate the torch when you are tired or under the influence of alcohol, drugs or intoxicating medication.
- × DO NOT hold the workpiece by hand. Use clamps or a vice (not included) to secure the workpiece.

2. INTRODUCTION

Professional micro design featuring piezoelectric ignition. Fitted with automatic safety lock. Unit produces flame of up to 1300°C and will operate for up to 45 minutes on a single fill. Features adjustable flame control and continuous flame function. Powered by Butane (lighter fuel).

3. PREPARATION

3.1. TO FILL (Refer to fig.1)

Use standard butane fuel. Fill in a well ventilated area away from open flame. Turn the torch off, make sure the flame is out, allow to cool down for five minutes before filling.

- 3.1.1. Hold torch upside down and insert the filling can's nozzle into the gas filling valve. Press nozzle into the valve and release gas. Once gas begins to seep out around the edge of the nozzle, the gas tank is full. Remove the filling can.
- 3.1.2. Allow excess gas to disperse before use.



4. OPERATION

- 4.1. Slide ignite button release down, then press ignite button to light.
- 4.2. Release ignite button to extinguish.
- 4.3. CONTINUOUS FLAME: With ignite button still depressed, push continuous button in.
- 4.4. Press ignite button and release to extinguish.
