2. INTRODUCTION

2-in-1 staple and nail gun. Heavy-duty reinforced heat treated carbon steel handle with a PVC casing. Sliding magazine for easy clearance of any blockages. Suitable for a wide range of applications. Supplied with a starter pack of 150 staples and nails.

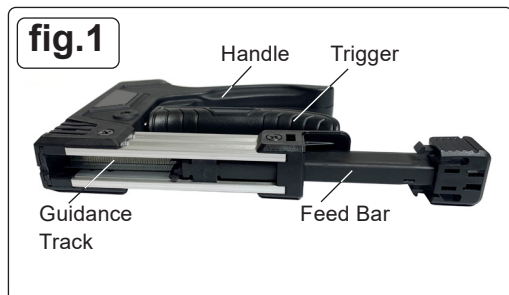

4. OPERATION

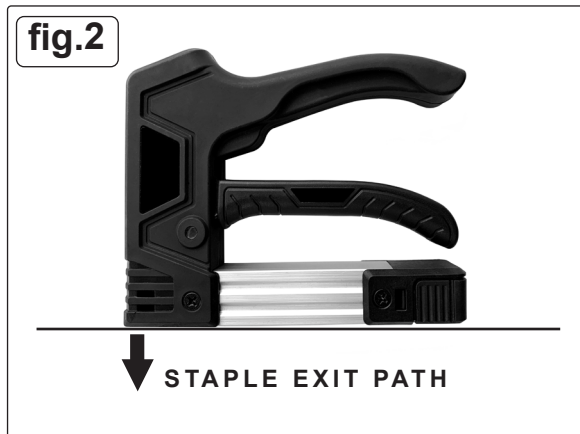
4.1. LOADING

- 4.1.1. Hold the stapler in one hand and point away from your body. Push in with finger and thumb at the base of the stapler feed bar and withdraw it from the stapler. Insert new staples or nails into the guidance track. See (fig.1) for staple placement within the track. Reinsert the feed bar upwards to retain it.



4.2. STAPLING

- 4.2.1. Prior to stapling, ensure that the stapler is correctly positioned and the sole plate is in firm contact with the surfaced to be stapled. Firmly depress the trigger until the gun fires. See (fig.2).



4.3. HOW TO CLEAR BLOCKAGES

Remove the feed bar (fig.1) and any loose staples remaining in the guidance track. Clear any damaged staples away from the staple exit path. Close the feed bar back into place.

4.4. STAPLE REMOVAL

4.4.1. Release the feed bar. Move the stapler onto it's side, the staples will exit out from the guidance track. Close the feed bar after.

4.5. STORAGE

4.5.1. Store in a dry place out of the reach of children.
