
2. INTRODUCTION

Thick 25mm MDF worktop, used for adding extra rigidity and durability. Powder coated steel frame, for added corrosion resistance. Four adjustable feet for levelling on uneven ground. Some simple assembly required.

5. ASSEMBLY

- 5.1. Fit top beams to each leg section using rubber hammer, no fixings required.
- 5.2. Fit bottom beams to each leg section using rubber hammer, no fixings required.
- 5.3. Adjust feet to level worktop.
- 5.4. Fit top, fix from underneath using 12 supplied self-tapping screws.

6. MAINTENANCE

- 6.1. Regularly check full engagement of beams (items 3 and 4) with H Leg Frames (items 2) in order to maintain stability of the bench.
- 6.2. Gently brush off the work surface and beams after use.
- 6.3. Clean the work surface and beams with a soft cloth and a mild water/detergent solution.
