ASSEMBLY

Simply push fit together as per the diagram - no tools are required. Ensure all shelves are facing in the same direction (curved side towards the front). Once assembled, the unit can be secured to a wall using the two brackets supplied. Two connecting brackets are also supplied for connecting two units together.
