2. INTRODUCTION

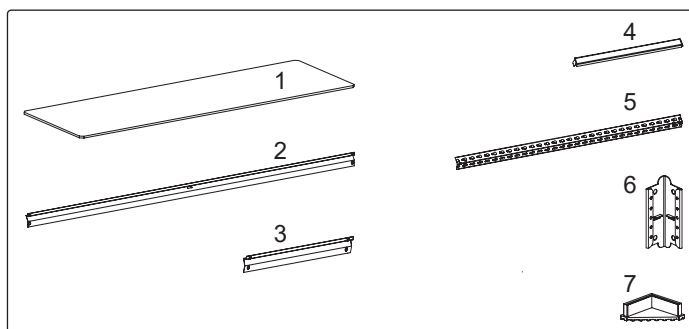

5. ASSEMBLY

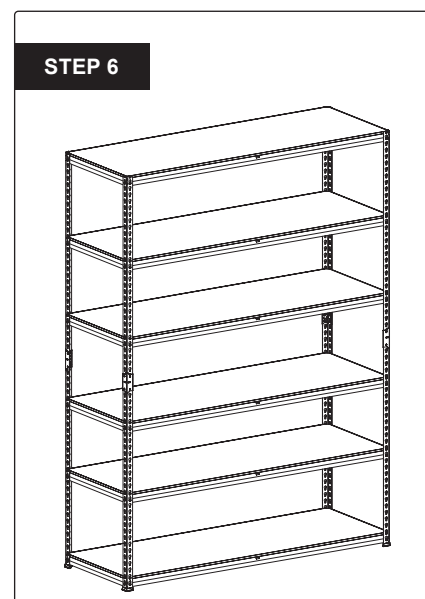
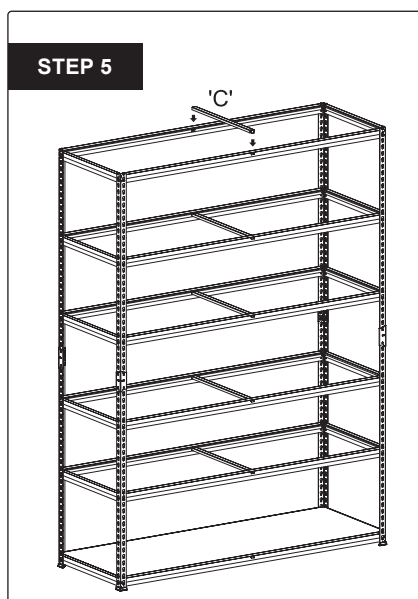
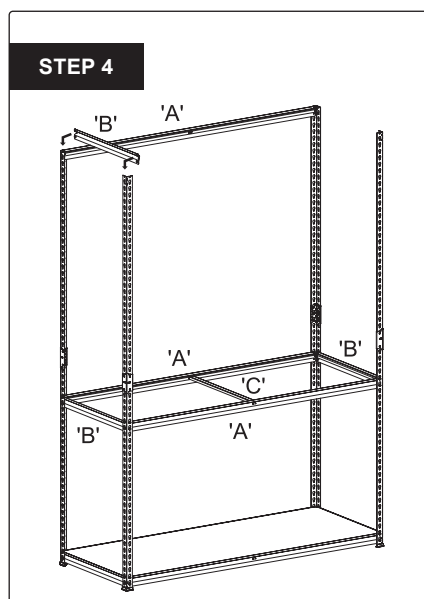


Step 1. Fit the foot caps to the bottom of the four legs (D), ensuring the legs are correctly orientated. Fit the shelving bracket (A) onto the legs (D). If required, gently tap the brackets into the keyholes in the legs using a rubber mallet.

Step 2. Fit shelf brackets (B) to the sides, using the shelf bracket fitted in Step 1 as a reference for the correct height. Position the shelf brackets on the opposite sides at the same height, as shown in the diagram. Fit brace (C) as illustrated.

Step 3. Join the upper legs to the lower legs using the connector plates.

NOTE: Position each upper leg directly on top of the corresponding lower leg. The legs must be aligned end-to-end and must not overlap.



Step 4. Place one MDF shelf onto the bottom shelf brackets to reduce frame movement during assembly. Fit brackets (A) and (B) to the top of the leg uprights, then fit the remaining brackets at the desired shelf heights.

Step 5. Once all shelf brackets have been set to the desired heights, fit all braces (C) as shown in the diagram above.

Step 6. Place the remaining MDF shelves onto the shelf brackets, ensuring each shelf is fully seated and sits flush against the edges of the brackets. Refer to the next page for instructions on fitting the supplied tip-over prevention kit.

❑ **WARNING!** It is strongly recommended that this product is securely anchored. Furniture that tips over can cause serious injury or death. A tip-over prevention kit is supplied with this product to help prevent it from tipping forwards. For your safety, securely fix the product to a wall or other solid structure using the supplied fixings.

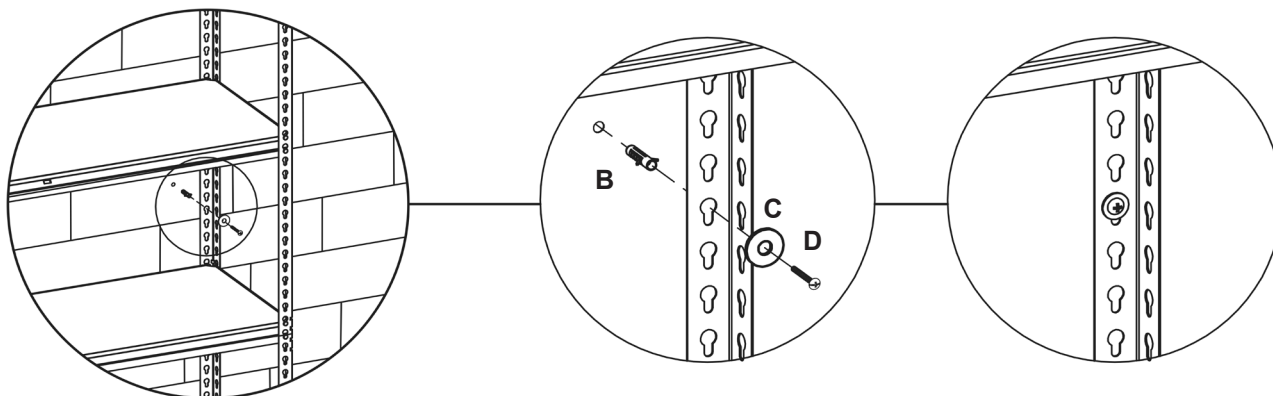
IMPORTANT: Regularly check that the wall fixings remain secure. The stability of tall furniture may be affected by thick-pile carpets or uneven floors.

CAUTION: Before fitting the wall fixings, please observe the following:

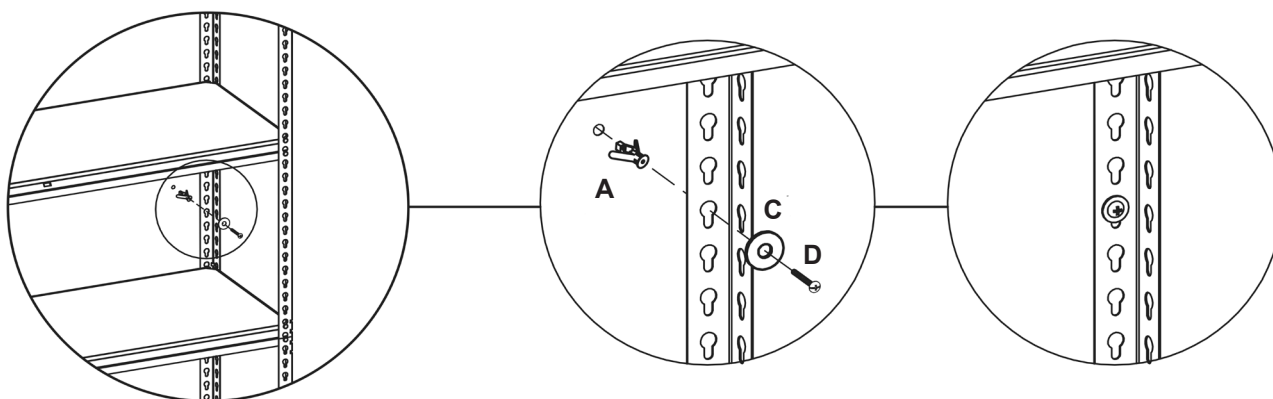
1. Check for concealed electrical cables, water pipes or gas pipes before drilling into the wall. If you are unsure, seek advice from a qualified tradesperson.
