### 1. SAFETY

### 2. INTRODUCTION

Fully painted steel frame with six MDF shelves. Space-saving corner unit with 150kg capacity per level giving a maximum capacity of 900kg per rack. Boltless design means no tools required to assemble. Slots together in minutes. 2-Piece uprights allow use as a single bay rack or split into two separate shelf systems or workstations. Ideal for use in conjunction with Model No's. AP7300 and AP7301 Racking Units.

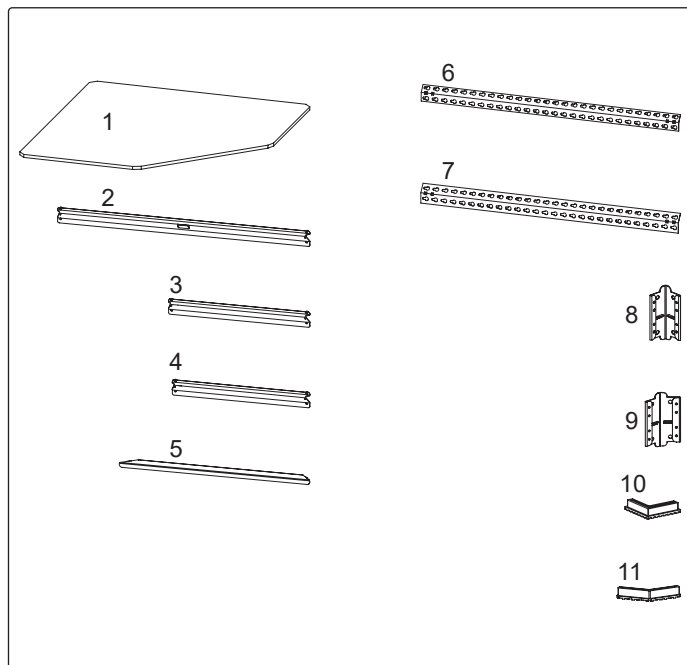

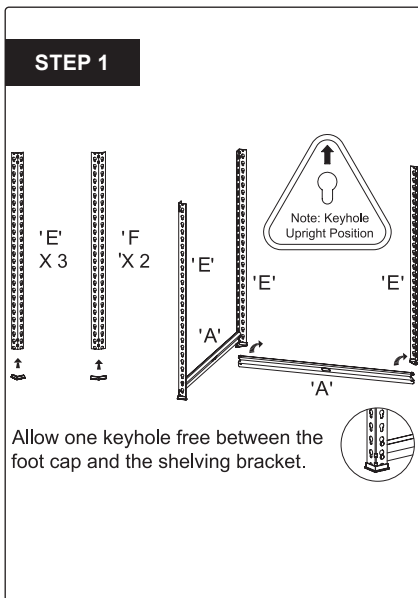

## 5. ASSEMBLY



### Step 1. ASSEMBLE THE BASE FRAME

Fit the Rubber Feet to the bottom of the Legs (E & F). Place the Shelving Brackets (A) onto the legs, as shown.

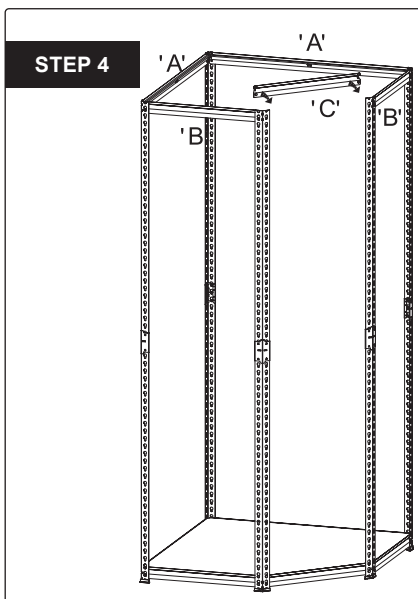
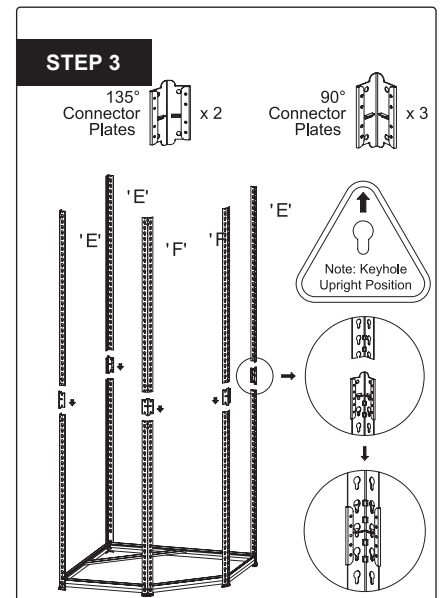
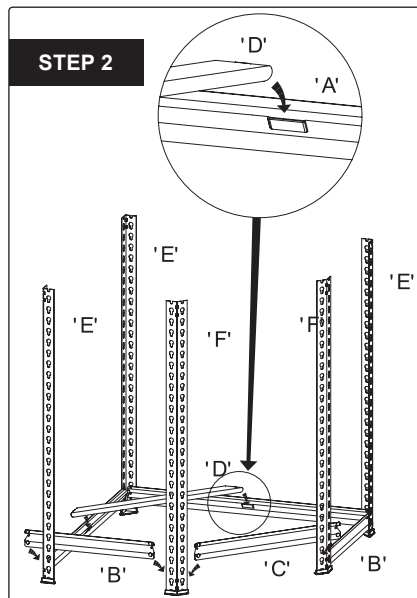
### Step 2. ASSEMBLE THE REMAINING FRAME

Use two Shelf Brackets (B) for the side brackets, using the Shelf Bracket from Step 1 as a guide for the height. Then fit Shelf Bracket (C), as shown in the diagram. Fit Brace (D), as shown.

### Step 3. ATTACH THE SHORT BEAMS

Join the upper and lower legs using the Connector Plates, as shown in the diagram. Ensure the uprights are positioned correctly.

**NOTE:** The legs are designed to sit directly on top of each other. **DO NOT** overlap them.



### Step 4. FIT THE BRACKETS

Use two Shelf Brackets (A), two Shelf Brackets (B) and one Shelf Bracket (C) to join the tops of the legs together, as shown.

### Step 5. FIT THE SHELVING

Repeat Step 4 for the remaining shelves. We recommend working from the base upwards, as this will make it easier to fit the MDF shelves.

### Step 6. FITTING THE BRACES

Apply the remaining Brackets as shown, positioning them at the desired height. Ensure that Braces (D) are fitted to all shelves.

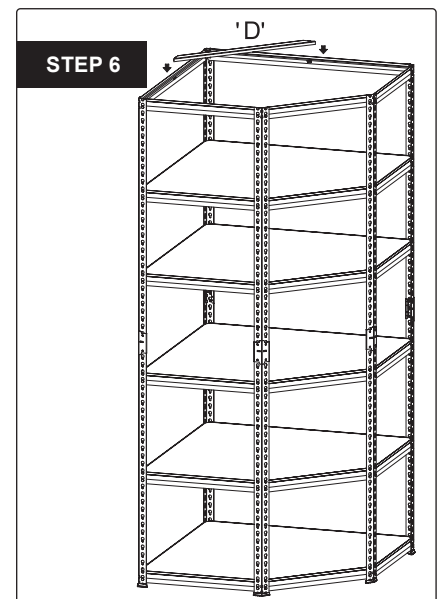
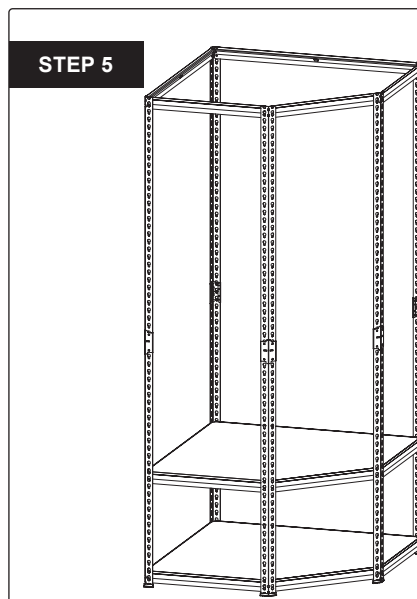

**IMPORTANT:** Regularly check that the wall fixings remain secure. The stability of tall furniture may be affected by thick-pile carpets or uneven floors.

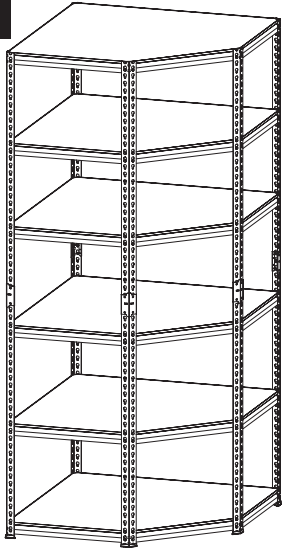
**CAUTION:** Before fitting to the wall, please observe the following:

2. Walls are constructed from different materials, such as solid masonry or plasterboard-lined cavity walls.



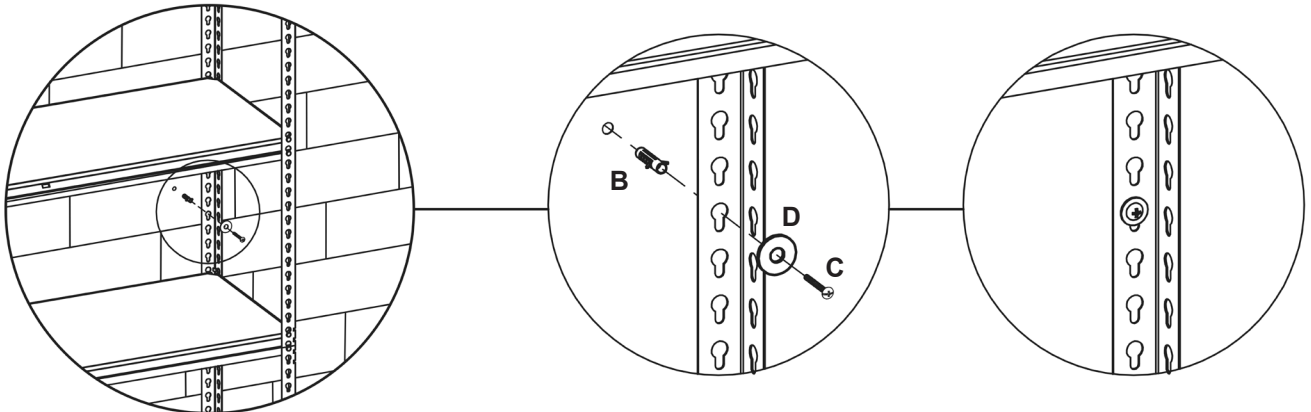
Always use fixings that are suitable for your wall type. If necessary, seek advice from a qualified hardware retailer or tradesperson.

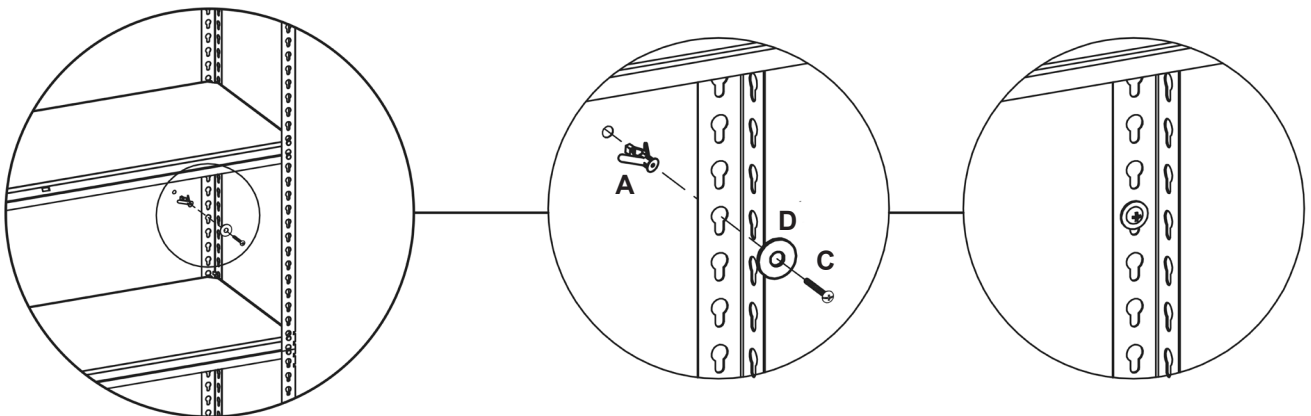
