



INSTRUCTIONS FOR :- SUPERLINE TOOL CHESTS & ROLLER CABINETS

Models: AP9801, AP9802, AP9803, AP9805, AP9806, AP9807 & AP9833

1. SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

- ✓ Engage castor brakes whenever tool cabinet is stationary.
- ✓ **DO NOT** open more than one loaded drawer at a time, as the chest or cabinet may become unstable.
- ✓ To reduce the risk of personal injury, push, rather than pull, the tool cabinet.
- ✓ The handle must be attached to the same end of the cabinet as the braked castors.
- ✓ Keep tool chest on a level surface, if placed on a platform ensure that platform is of adequate strength.
- ✓ Lock drawers and doors before moving or lifting tool chest or cabinet, thus avoiding accidental opening and personal injury.
- ✓ When the chest cover is opened, be sure the cover hinges are in the locked position.
- ✓ Remember to unlock hinges before closing the cover.
- ✗ **DO NOT** leave open drawers unattended.
- ✗ **DO NOT** attempt to force a drawer closed if the other drawers are locked - the locking mechanism will be damaged.
- ✗ **DO NOT** stand on the chest or cabinet, or step in the drawers.
- ✗ **DO NOT** tow cabinet behind a vehicle.
- ✗ **DO NOT** alter this product in any manner. For example, do not weld external lock bars or attach electrical equipment. This may cause product damage and/or personal injury.

2. ASSEMBLY

- **WARNING!** All roller cabinets must have the handle attached to the same end of the cabinet as the two braked castors.

2.1. CASTORS - CABINETS

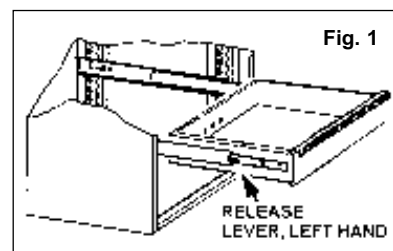
- 2.1.1. Remove the bottom drawer, see Section 3. On model AP9803, open storage compartment.
- 2.1.2. Place the cabinet on its back. Use packing material to protect the paintwork.
- 2.1.3. Attach the castors to the bottom panel using 4 bolts, washers and nuts per castor. Fit the bolts so that the heads are inside the cabinet with the washers and nuts clamping the castor mounting plates.
- 2.1.4. Stand cabinet upright.

2.2. HANDLE - CABINETS

- 2.2.1. Pass the handle brackets down through the slots in the end panel and retain with screws and washers.

3. DRAWER REMOVAL

- 3.1. Empty the drawer, then fully open it.
- 3.2. Lift the safety catch release lever (Fig. 1) on the left hand slide and press down the lever on the right hand slide - pull the drawer out to remove.
- 3.3. Refit by engaging drawer slides in slide channels and then pushing the drawer closed. The safety catches will be heard to engage.



4. MAINTENANCE

- 4.1. Castors should be lubricated periodically with a high quality grease.
- 4.2. Drawer slides should be lubricated twice yearly with a light grease or petroleum jelly.
- 4.3. Drawer fronts, trim and other surfaces should be cleaned periodically with mild detergent and water. **DO NOT USE** abrasives.
- 4.4. The lustre finish is best preserved with an auto wax. Apply the wax as to a car to help protect the unit against scratches.
- 4.5. Grease and oil can be removed with most cleaning fluids. It is recommended for safety reasons that a nonflammable solution is used.
- 4.6. Drawer liners are supplied and it is recommended they are used to protect the finish inside the drawers and to reduce 'tool slide'. Drawer liners may be cleaned with soap and water.
