1. SAFETY



- Assemble the unit on a solid level surface. Avoid carpet.
- ✓ Wear protective gloves and eyewear when assembling this product.
- This product has been tested to safely carry a load of up to 1200kg even distributed, when properly installed and maintained.
- ✓ Heaviest items should be loaded on the lowest shelves.

2. INTRODUCTION

Textured powder coat steel frame with four heavy-duty powder coated steel mesh shelves. Industrial structured beams offers added strength with 300kg capacity per level, giving a maximum capacity of 1200kg per rack. Boltless design means no tools required to assemble. Specifically designed and sized drawer units and cupboards available to keep storage tidy, see model numbers APMB1, APMB2, APMB3, APMB4 and APMB5 (sold separately).




4. ASSEMBLY

4.1. Unpack the unit and confirm that you have all the parts listed.


NOTE: for evenly spaced shelves (from bottom shelf): 14 free keyholes, 13 free keyholes, 13 free keyholes.




PLEASE NOTE: Tip-over prevention kit included (refer to last page for installation).




Add Rubber Feet (Part F) to bottom of Angle Posts (Part A). Slot Short Beams (Part C) to the bottom of the Angle Posts (Part A) as shown, followed by Long Beams (Part B) to opposing keyholes (in holes 2nd and 3rd from bottom). NOTE: Flat edges face outwards. Lock rivets to the bottom of the keyhole by tapping the Beams with a rubber mallet.




Fasten Short Beams (Part C) to the top of the Angle Posts (Part A) as shown, followed by Long Beams (Part B) to opposing keyholes to form the frame. NOTE: Flat edges face outwards. Lock rivets to the bottom of the keyhole by tapping the Beams with a Rubber Mallet.




Assemble remaining Short Beams (Part C) and Long Beams (Part B) to your desired shelf height. As before, lock rivets to the bottom of the keyhole by tapping the Beams with a rubber mallet.





5. TIP OVER PREVENTION

- WARNING! Toppling furniture can cause serious injuries and death. It is strongly recommended that you anchor this product. A 'tip-over prevention kit' has been provided with this product to stop your furniture from tipping forward. It is strongly recommended that you securely attach this product to a wall or other solid surface using the provided fixings.
 - **IMPORTANT:** regularly check that anchors are securely maintained. Stability of tall items may be affected by thick pile carpet or uneven floors.
 - **CAUTION:** For your safety when attaching the anchor fixings, please note the following:
- Check for any electrical wires or plumbing inside the wall before drilling any holes. If you are unsure please seek professional advice from a qualified tradesperson.
- ✓ Walls are constructed from different materials, for example, masonry (solid brick) or plasterboard lined cavity walls (hollow). It is important that you use the appropriate wall fixings fro your wall type.
