

INSTRUCTIONS FOR:

CHARCOAL 17" BBQ

1. SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

1.1. GENERAL SAFETY

- WARNING! USE OUTDOORS ONLY. Be aware burning (or smouldering) charcoal gives off lethal amounts of Carbon Monoxide (CO).
- WARNING! Accessable parts may be very hot. Keep young children away.
- **DO NOT** move the barbecue whilst it is in operation.
- **X DO NOT** when using your barbecue, leave it unattended.
- X DO NOT use this barbecue in a garage or any enclosed area (including tents). Keep the area in which it is being used clear (at least one metre) of any combustable materials.
- **DO NOT** light the barbecue on a surface that may be damaged by hot fat or heat.
- X DO NOT light the barbecue in an area of dry vegetation.
- ✓ Be prepared if an accident or a fire should occur. Know where your first aid kit and fire extinguishers are and how to use them correctly.
- ✓ Always cook with great care.
- ✓ Stand on a level surface.
- ✓ Use oven gloves and sturdy long handled barbecue tools when cooking.
- ✓ Keep pets and children at a safe distance.
- ✓ The barbecue will become hot so handle with the help of oven gloves.

2. INTRODUCTION & SPECIFICATION

Traditional kettle style barbecue, finished in porcelain enamel. Chrome plated cooking grill providing generous cooking area. Wire shelf for storage and stability, drip tray, sturdy lid handles and wheels for ease of movement.

3. ASSEMBLY

3.1 Refer to the Parts diagram attached.

When starting to assemble, remove all of the parts from the packaging and check if anything is missing against the parts list.

- 3.1.1. Place leg cups (9) over the ends of the three legs. Screw the two short legs (10) and the long leg (14) to the firebowl (7).
- 3.1.2. Place the sharp tip of rack (13) into the hole in bottom of long leg (14). Then put the other two tips through the holes of the two short legs (10) and attach the wheels (11) using lock nuts and washers (C).
- 3.1.3. Fasten the firebowl handle (6) onto the firebowl (7) using screws/nuts/washers (B).
- 3.1.4. Fasten the ash access door (8) to the outside bottom of the firebowl (7) using screw/nut/washer A.
- 3.1.5. Fit the ashtray (15) between the three legs using the cutouts in its edge.
- 3.1.6. Fit the hood handle (1) to the outside of the hood (2) and fit the hood bracket (3) on the inside, with screws/nuts/washers (B).
- 3.1.7. Fit vent cap (12) onto the lid (2) using screw/nut/washer (A).
- 3.1.8. Place the charcoal grate (5) and the cooking grill (4) into the firebowl (7) and put on the hood (2).



OPERATION

- WARNING! Ensure that you are familiar with the Safety Instructions in Section 1 before use.
- 4.1 Remove the cooking grill (4) and place the charcoal onto the charcoal grate (5) to light it. Replace the grill (4) before you start cooking.
- 4.2 When cooking is finished, make sure the barbecue has completely cooled before storing.


