1. SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

- Always distribute the load evenly over the surface of the bed.
- DO NOT overload the truck see Specification.
- DO NOT leave unattended, especially when loaded, unless the wheels are chocked or the truck is otherwise secured.
- DO NOT use truck on uneven ground and do not run over curbs or steps - use a ramp.
- **DO NOT** allow others to ride on the truck.
- DO NOT use the truck if any part is damaged, paying particular attention to the wheels.
- DO NOT inflate the tyres to more than 30psi.

3. INTRODUCTION

Heavy-duty tubular steel framed construction with hinged mesh. Cushioned grip pull handle with smooth steering action for easy manoeuvrability. Foldable body ideal for easy storage. Fitted with four steel centred pneumatic wheels allowing smooth transport over the toughest terrain. Suitable for a wide variety of warehouse, office, garden and domestic hauling applications.

4. ASSEMBLY

- 4.1 Remove the platform truck from its packaging.
- Go over the platform truck and ensure all fixings are secure 42 paying particular attention to the castors and handle.
- 4.3 Stand the folded platform truck on its wheels. Expand the truck by pulling each end outwards. (fig.1)

TRUCK OPERATION

- 5.1 Check tyre pressures on the truck on a regular basis. Do not inflate above 30psi.
- 5.2 Do not overload the truck and ensure that the load is evenly distributed before setting off.
- 5.3 When towing the truck proceed at a safe speed especially at corners where there could be a danger of the load shifting.
- Extra care should be taken on inclined surfaces. 5.4
- If the truck is loaded and left unattended the wheels should 5.5 be chocked
- 5.6 Where there is a curb or step, a ramp should be used.
- When finished, collapse the platform truck by pulling upwards 5.7 on the central hinges (fig.2)
