## 1. SAFETY

### 1.1. GENERAL SAFETY

- ❑ **WARNING!** The warnings, cautions and instructions in this manual cannot cover all possible conditions and situations that may occur. It must be understood by the operator that common sense and caution are factors which cannot be built into this product, but must be applied by the operator. Ensure a safe working space of at least a metre exists around the assembling the unit.
- ✓ Use recommended parts only. Unauthorised parts may be dangerous and will invalidate the warranty.
- ✓ Use the trolley only on flat, level surfaces.
- ✓ Never exceed the maximum load capacity of 40 kg per tray.
- ✓ Ensure loads are evenly distributed across each tray.
- ✗ **DO NOT** stand, sit, climb, or ride on the trolley.
- ✓ Never use the trolley as a skateboard, step, or ladder.
- ✓ Keep hands, feet, and loose clothing away from the castor wheels during movement.
- ✗ **DO NOT** use the trolley on slopes, ramps, uneven terrain, or stairs.
- ✓ Avoid rolling the trolley over cables, debris, or floor cracks as this may damage the castors.
- ✓ Inspect the trolley regularly for loose fasteners, damaged wheels, or cracks.
- ✗ **DO NOT** modify the trolley or use non-approved parts.

## 2. INTRODUCTION

Composite garage workshop trolley with a 40kg capacity per level, featuring shelves with four integrated slots for organising tools or bottles. Fitted with four swivel castors for easy movement, slots together in minutes and is supplied with two removable waste bins for simple cleaning and spill control.

## 4. CONTENTS

- 3 × Polypropylene trays.
- 8 × Polypropylene support posts.
- 4 × Rubber swivel castors.
- 2 × Polypropylene handles.
- 2 x Bins.
- Fixings (screws as supplied).

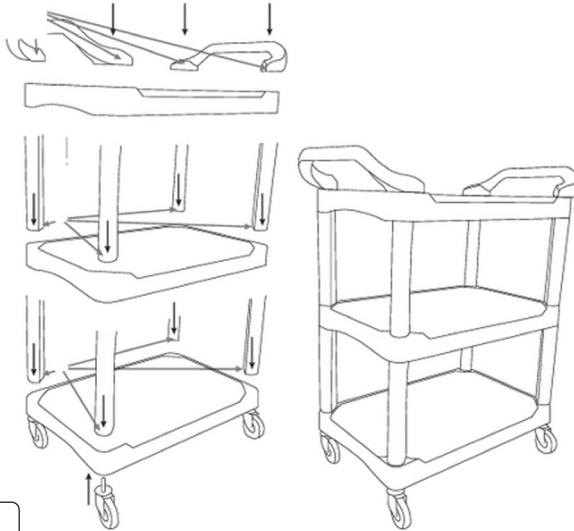


## 5. ASSEMBLY SEE FIG.1

- 5.1. Attach the four castor wheels to the base tray and ensure they are securely fastened.
- 5.2. Insert the support posts into each corner of the base tray.
- 5.3. Secure the support posts using the supplied screws.
- 5.4. Place the middle tray onto the support posts and secure it.
- 5.5. Repeat the process for the top tray.
- 5.6. Attach the handles to the top tray and secure with the supplied screws.
- 5.7. Check that all fixings are tight before use.

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## 6. OPERATION

- 6.1. Push the trolley using the handles; **DO NOT** pull from the side trays.
- 6.2. Move slowly, especially when fully loaded.
- 6.3. Stop the trolley completely before adding or removing items.
- 6.4. Use caution when operating in confined or busy work areas.

## 7. MAINTENANCE

- 7.1. Check all screws, posts, and castors periodically and tighten if required.
- 7.2. Clean using mild detergent and water.
- \* **DO NOT** use abrasive cleaners or solvents.
- 7.3. Store in a dry, secure location when not in use.

## 8. STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

- 8.1. Store the trolley in a safe location away from children.
- \* **DO NOT** stack heavy objects on the trolley when stored.
- 8.2. Dispose of the product in accordance with local waste and recycling regulations.
