## 1. SAFETY

- Replace damaged parts. Use recommended parts only. Unauthorised parts may be dangerous and will invalidate the warranty.
- ✓ Keep the drainer clean, dry and in good condition for best and safest performance.
- √ Wear appropriate PPE. Protective clothing, gloves, eye protection and non-slip safety shoes are recommended.
- ✓ If it is necessary to raise the vehicle, ensure that it is properly supported.
- ✓ If the vehicle has been raised with a jack, axle stands must be put in place before working under the vehicle.
- ✓ Remove the oil drainer and other tools and equipment from underneath the vehicle before lowering it again.
- Use the drainer in a suitable work area.
- ✓ Keep the work area clean, tidy, well-lit and free from unrelated materials.
- ✓ The work area should have a flat and level surface capable of supporting the weight of the drainer and it's contents.
- ✓ Ensure that the floor is not slippery and wear non-slip safety shoes.
- ✓ Keep children and unauthorised persons away from the work area.
- ✓ Dispose of waste liquids in accordance with local authority regulations.
- DO NOT position the drainer in such a way that it becomes a hazard to others in the work area.
- **DO NOT** use the drainer in wet or damp areas or where condensation is present.

#### 2. INTRODUCTION

Ensures safe and clean collection, transportation and temporary storage of waste oil. Features heavy-duty construction with wheeled undercarriage for easier transportation of full drainer. Stores flat or in upright position. Supplied with additional tap for alternative draining method.

## 4. OPERATION

## **REFER TO FIG.1**

- 4.1. Ensure the container is flat before receiving oil.
- 4.2. Open the lid and wing plugs.
- 4.3. Fill the container with up to 57L of oil.

**NOTE:** Keep the contain flat when it is full of oil. Storing the container upright when full may cause product deformation.

- 4.4. Close the lid and wing plugs.
- 4.5. Open the drain valve or cap to drain the oil from the container.
