1. SAFETY

1.1. ELECTRICAL SAFETY

USE ONLY THE SUPPLIED MAINS CHARGER PLUG FOR CONNECTING FLOODLIGHT TO THE MAINS POWER SUPPLY.

- WARNING! It is the user's responsibility to read, understand and comply with the following electrical instructions:
 You must ensure the risk of electric shock is minimised by the installation of appropriate safety devices. An RCCB (Residual Current Circuit Breaker) should be incorporated in the main distribution board. We also recommend that an RCD (Residual Current Device) is used with all electrical products, particularly portable equipment which is plugged into an electrical supply not protected by an RCCB.
 - You must also read and understand the following instructions concerning electrical safety.
- 1.1.1. **The Electricity At Work Act 1989** requires all portable electrical appliances, if used on business premises, to be tested by a qualified electrician, using a Portable Appliance Tester (PAT), at least once a year.
- 1.1.2. The Health & Safety at Work Act 1974 makes owners of electrical appliances responsible for the safe condition of the appliance and the safety of the appliance operator. If in any doubt about electrical safety, contact a qualified electrician.
- 1.1.3. You must ensure that you:
 - ✓ Inspect the charger plug, cable and connector for wear and damage to ensure items are safe before connecting to the mains power supply. If worn or damaged **DO NOT** use.
 - Check cables are always protected against short circuit and overload.
 - ▲ Important: Check that the voltage marked on the charger plug is the same as the power supply to be used.
 - ✓ Uncoil the cable between charger and the floodlight.
 - DO NOT pull the charger plug from the mains socket by the lead.
 - DO NOT use any other type of charger with this product.
 - DO NOT place the connector into any area of the floodlight except the correct jack inlet socket.
 - **DO NOT** try to take the charger plug apart.
 - **DO NOT** use the charger plug to charge or power any other electrical item.
 - **DO NOT** get the charger wet, or use in wet, damp conditions (for indoor use only).
 - WARNING! NEVER substitute a standard 13Amp 3 pin plug, or any other type of plug, for the charger plug.

1.2. BATTERY SAFETY

- WARNING! To reduce the risk of burns or fire:
 - DO NOT attempt to open, disassemble, modify or service the battery.
- ✓ Ensure the charger is switched off and disconnected from the floodlight before attempting to open the lamp unit.
- **DO NOT** expose to temperatures above 60°C (140°F).
- **DO NOT** crush, puncture, short external contacts or dispose of in fire or water.
- ✓ Replace only with the battery designated for this product.
- Dispose of the old batteries in accordance with local authority battery regulations. **DO NOT** dispose of with regular refuse.
- ✓ If the electrolyte in the cells contacts the skin, wash thoroughly with soap and water.
- ✓ If the electrolyte in the cells gets into the eyes, rinse thoroughly with cool water and seek immediate medical attention.

1.3. GENERAL SAFETY

- Ensure the floodlight is correctly charged before initial use.
- DO NOT cover or block the lens during use.
- DO NOT turn the floodlight on when it is being re-charged.
- DO NOT shine directly into your, other person's or animal's eyes.
- DO NOT allow children to use the floodlight.
- DO NOT handle or move the floodlight whilst it is being charged.
- DO NOT use the floodlight if you suspect that the battery or the spotlight casing is damaged.
- **DO NOT** immerse the floodlight in water.
- Ensure replacement batteries are genuine Sealey batteries of the same rating.
- Ensure the floodlight is unplugged and allowed to cool before attempting any cleaning or replacement.
- ✓ When not in use store the floodlight in a safe, dry, childproof location.

2. INTRODUCTION

Portable, rechargeable floodlight with built in high quality wireless speakers, which can be easily connected to your smart phone or tablet to play music. Die-cast aluminium housing with handle and integral 180° adjustable stand. Features a removeable battery pack which includes a Powerbank, LED torch and battery charge level indicator. Main floodlight with on/off power button with five brightness options, from 100lm up to 2000lm. Built-in memory function for brightness. Light and speakers can be used whilst charging. Supplied with charger. IP65 Rated.

The battery fitted to this lamp is considered to be a consumable item and its ability to accept a charge will reduce over time. We will provide warranty against mechanical and electrical defect for a period of one year - this does not cover fair wear and tear. If the battery is not properly charged before first use, or regularly conditioned, its capacity will diminish. Under these circumstances we will not replace the battery regardless of whether it is less than one year old.

Note: The lithium battery does not suffer from memory effect and once fully charged may be stored for up to six months without another charge.

4. OPERATION

■ WARNING! Ensure that the safety instructions are read and fully understood before use.

4.1. CHARGING

4.1.1. Charge the battery before use. Only use the charger supplied. The Battery level indicator, fig.1.3 and fig.3 indicates charge level.

- 4.2. WIRELESS CONNECTION refer to fig's 1 & 2
- 4.2.1. Press Wireless On/Off button, fig.1.11, once to turn on wireless connection, press again to turn off.
- 4.2.2. The device will sound, 'Ready to pair' and once paired, 'Your device has paired sucessfully.'

NOTE: The Wireless connection will turn off after 2 minutes with no connection being made.

- 4.2.3. The Wireless name is: 'LED WORKLIGHT'.
- 4.2.4. Adjust the volume using the Brightness (+) and (-) buttons, fig.1.8 and fig.1.10.
- 4.3. MAIN LIGHT
- 4.3.1. Press Main Light button, fig.1.9 once for on and again for off.
- 4.3.2. Press Brightness + button, fig.1.8 to increase the brightness and Brightness button, fig.1.10 to reduce the brightness.
- 4.3.3. The memory function will turn the light back on to the level it was at, when it was last turned on.



- 4.4. TORCH refer to fig's 3 & 4
- 4.4.1. Press release button, fig.1.2 and slide Powerbank away from lamp.
- 4.4.2. Press On/Off button, fig1.4 to turn torch on and again to turn torch off.

NOTE: The torch can only be turned on when the battery pack is removed from the Main light. The torch is automatically turned off when the battery pack is connected to the main light again.

- 4.5. POWERBANK refer to fig's 1, 3 & 4
- 4.5.1. Press Powerbank On/Off button, fig.1.5 to turn the USB output on. Press again to turn off.
- 4.6. BATTERY LEVEL INDICATOR Refer to fig's 1,3 & 4
- 4.6.1. Each LED bar on the Battery level indicator is worth 25% of the remaining charge, all 4 bars lit = fully charged, red bar lit =25% charge remaining.
- 4.7. DISCHARGE INDICATOR TORCH ONLY refer to fig.4
- 4.7.1. Each bar indicates 25% of charge remaining.
- 4.8. LOW VOLTAGE WARNING
- 4.8.1. The Main light will flash 3 times when the voltage is low.
