1. SAFETY

2. INTRODUCTION

Produces extremely bright white light with an output of 2000 lumen and a working range of up to 500 metres. Slide action head adjusts focus from spotlight to wide beam. Two function on/off push button for full and 30% modes. Lightweight aluminium housing. Powered by 2 x rechargeable Lithium-ion 3.7V 2Ah batteries. Supplied with micro USB charging lead.

4. OPERATION

- 4.1. Remove battery compartment screw cap.(fig.1)
- 4.2. Insert 2 x 7.4V 2Ah batteries into compartment (positive ends first) and replace cap.
- 4.3. To switch on press on/mode-change/off button (fig.1), press again to change mode, press again to switch off.
- 4.4. Focus can be adjusted from spotlight to wide angle by sliding head of torch back or forwards.
- 4.5. To charge Torch, rotate collar (fig.1) sufficiently to be able to connect USB cable and turn power supply on.
- 4.6. When charging LEDs flash green. When fully charged LEDs show steady green light.

5. MAINTENANCE

- 5.1. Keep the torch clean by wiping with a damp cloth.
- 5.2. Remove batteries if not being used for a long period of time.
- 5.3. Store torch and batteries in a dry childproof area.
