1. SAFETY


- Maintain the log rack in good condition.
- Replace or repair damaged parts. Use recommended parts only. Unauthorised parts may be dangerous and will invalidate the warranty.
- **DO NOT** modify the product.
- ✓ Inspect before each use. Check security of fasteners.
- ✓ Keep the log rack clean.
- Locate the log rack in a suitable working area. Keep area clean and tidy and ensure there is adequate lighting. Keep bystanders away.
- ✓ Ensure legs are deployed and locked into position.
- Ensure the log is correctly held and balanced before commencing work. Consider using straps or additional clamps to secure the log. DO NOT allow logs to move whilst being cut.
- DO NOT exceed the weight capacity.
- DO NOT attempt to cut logs that exceed the rated diameter. DO NOT attempt to cut logs that are tool long and will upset the stability of the saw horse.
- Maintain correct balance and footing. Ensure the floor/ground is not slippery and wear non-slip shoes and appropriate protective clothing for the task in hand. Follow all safety protocols for the tool being used to cut the log.
- **DO NOT** use the log rack for any purpose other than that for which it is designed.
- DO NOT operate the log rack if any parts are missing as this may cause failure and/or personal injury.
- DO NOT use the log rack if you are tired or under the influence of drugs, alcohol or medication.

2. INTRODUCTION

100kg capacity log sawhorse with 380mm log diameter to accommodate larger logs. Adjustable clamping adapts to different wood diameters. Fold-flat frame for space-saving storage and portability. Serrated sawhorse teeth clamp wood firmly for accurate cuts.



6. ASSEMBLY




STEP 1:FIT HANDLES

- 1. Take 4 long frame pieces (A).
- 2. Attach handles (B) to each frame piece using: Screw (1) through the handle into the frame. Secure with washer (2) and nut (3) on the inside.
- 3. Repeat for all four handles.

STEP 2: ASSEMBLE CROSS PIECE FRAMES

- Arrange 6 long frame pieces (A) into three pairs to form three "X" shapes.
- For each pair:
 Overlap the pieces at the centre.
 Fix them together using:
 Bolt (6) through the centre.
 Add large washer (5) on both sides.
 Secure with locking nut (4).
- 3. You should now have 3 X-shaped assemblies.



STEP 3: FIT CROSS PIECES

- 1. Position the three X-shaped assemblies upright.
- Attach short cross pieces (C) between the front and middle assembly.
- Attach long cross pieces (D) between the middle and back assembly.
- 4. Use screws (1), washers (2), and nuts (3) to secure each cross piece.

7. OPERATION

- 7.1. Follow recommendations in Safety section.
- 7.2. Unfold to use.
- 7.3. Check security of fixings before use.
- 7.4. Check for stability before using to cut logs.

8. MAINTENANCE

- 8.1. Lubricate hinge points.
- 8.2. Keep clean and store in a dry place.
