1. SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

- ✓ Always seat the masking paper securely on the shafts before attempting to move the trolley.
- ✗ Do not load more than three rolls of paper on the trolley.
- ✗ Do not allow others to ride on the trolley.
- ✓ Only use the trolley on firm, level, unobstructed surfaces which are capable of supporting the trolley and wheels.
- ✓ Replace or repair damaged parts. *Use only recommended parts. Unauthorised parts may be dangerous and will invalidate the warranty.*

2. INTRODUCTION AND SPECIFICATION

2.1 INTRODUCTION

2.1.1 Heavy-duty trolley with a three-station masking paper dispenser. It includes a weight-loaded cutter bar and masking tape dispenser for each station.

2.2 SPECIFICATION

- 2.2.1 Model No. MK69
- Roll sizes: 1 x 300mm.
- 2 x 450mm.

3. OPERATION

3.1 LOADING

- 3.1.1 Position the trolley on a flat, firm surface.
- 3.1.2 Load the masking paper securely on the shafts before attempting to move the trolley. Refer to Fig. 2.
- 3.1.3 Secure the rolls with the securing ring and knob. Screw until tight.
- 3.1.4 Place the masking tape on the loading bracket, ensuring that the roll is secure correctly fitted in relation to the masking paper. Refer to Fig. 2.

IMPORTANT! Ensure that the paper is correctly located prior to operating the dispenser.

3.2 ADJUSTING THE MASKING PAPER

- 3.2.1 Locate the spring, under the weight-loaded cutter bar, and feed the paper between the spring and the cutter bar. Ensure that the paper is centrally located and does not snag on the retaining spring.
- 3.2.2 Ensure smooth operation of the paper dispenser and masking tape by adjusting the paper position centrally. Ensure that the masking tape is adjusted such that it flows smoothly with the masking paper.

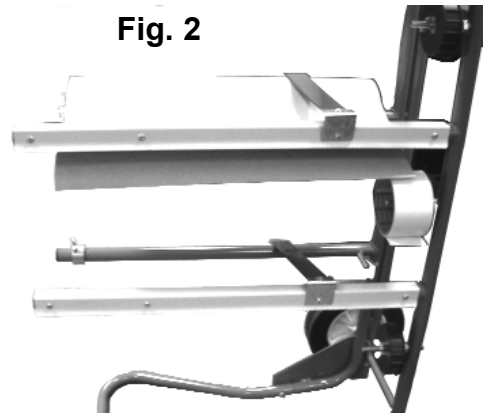
4. MAINTENANCE
