Steel framework with powder coat paint finish. 5" Composite swivel castors making it easier to travel over rough surfaces. Comfortable vinyl covered deep foam filled back and headrest. Easily assembled, castors and hardware provided. For the professional workshop.

4. ASSEMBLY

4.1. **REFER TO PARTS DIAGRAM**

- 4.2. **UNBOX AND ORGANIZE PARTS**

- 4.2.1. Lay out all the components, including the two board sections, casters wheels, and any included fasteners. Identify the main centre section and the two side sections.
- 4.2.2. Align components correctly.
- Secure the sections using the provided nuts and bolts. 4.2.3.
- 4.2.4. Install the casters wheels and ensure they spin freely.
- NOTE: When tighten all fasteners to ensure stability.
- 4.2.5. Attach the headrest/ cushion with self tapping screws.

FINAL CHECK 4.3.

- 4.3.1. All screws and bolts are securely tightened.
- Place the creeper on a smooth surface and test the wheels for proper movement. 4.3.2.

5. OPERATION

- WARNING! If you raise the vehicle to work under it, set the vehicle on axle stands.
- × DO NOT work under a vehicle raised on a jack(s).
- If the vehicle is on the ground, ensure the vehicle's wheels are chocked, apply the handbrake and put it into gear or Park mode.
- 5.1. As you slide under the vehicle and prior to sliding out on the creeper, keep your head flat on the headrest.

MAINTENANCE 6.

6.1. Before each use inspect the overall condition of the creeper for broken, cracked or bent parts that may effect the proper operation.
