1. SAFETY

2. INTRODUCTION

Strong heat resistant repair tape. Resists temperatures of up to 450°C. Adheres to metal, ceramics and porcelain. Rapid cure time.

4. OPERATION

- ▲ **DANGER!** Use protective gloves
- 4.0.1. Unwrap the roll and dip it in lukewarm water for 5 seconds
- 4.0.2. Squeeze the roll to remove any excess water
- 4.0.3. Start wrapping the roll around the area that needs to be repaired. Wrap at least 6 layers of tape over the break and at least 5-10cm of support on both sides of the break.
- 4.0.4. Wrap the repair with wire to secure it and keep the layers tight while it cures.
- 4.0.5. Heat the repair tape to cure it. See chart below for curing times and temperature. The repair will be fully cured in 12hours.
