1. SAFETY

2. INTRODUCTION

Heavy-duty galvanized welding table/workbench with 4 lockable swivel castors. Easily portable making it ideal to manoeuvre around the workshop or garage. Storage tray/shelf for parts and tool storage. 3mm Worktop features 16mm holes and 4 tool slots making it much easier to clamp and fix workpieces.

4.1. Assemble as per attached Parts Diagram.

5. OPERATION

- 5.1. Ensure castors are locked before use.
- 5.2. Secure workpieces using the cutouts and perforations in the top surface.

6. MAINTENANCE

- 6.1. Keep welding table clean by wiping down with a damp cloth, do not use solvents.
- 6.2. Check tightness of fasteners before each use.
- 6.3. Store in a dry, child free area.
