1. SAFETY

- WARNING! DO NOT operate using flammable liquids in a confined space, the area should have adequate ventilation.
- 1.2 If pumping flammable liquids, avoid proximity to naked flames or welding operations.
- 1.3 Wear appropriate protective clothing when pumping solvents. We particularly recommend eye/face and hand protection, available from your authorised Sealey dealer.
- 1.4 Keep children away from areas where solvents are being used.
- 1.5 Ensure Health & Safety, local authority, and general workshop practice regulations are adhered to when using this equipment.
- 1.6 Ensure any spillages are dealt with immediately. Failure to do so could lead to injury.

2. OPERATION

- 2.1 Open an appropriate drum. If the drum hole has a thread, screw the pump adaptor (A) on. If no thread is available, use the fastening screws (B) to secure the pump on the lip of the drum hole (do not over tighten screws as this may deform the lip and prevent the drum from being resealed).
- 2.2 For drums fitted with a pouring spout, a universal adaptor is available, model no. **TP99/1**, from your authorised Sealey dealer.
- 2.3 Adjust the height/rotation of the pump and fix in position using the plastic screw (C)
- 2.4 Fit the nozzle (D) onto the pump and unlock the plunger by turning the lock (E) anticlockwise.
- 2.5 Operate the plunger until the desired amount of liquid has been dispensed.
- 2.6 To remove the pump, perform the reverse of steps 2.4 2.1.

3. MAINTENANCE

- 3.1 The pump requires very little maintenance. Keep the pump clean and flush with clean water each time before fitting to a fresh barrel.
- 3.2 Over time and with significant use, the pump adaptor (A) may become worn. Replacements are available from your authorised Sealey dealer, model no. 114/A.
