2. INTRODUCTION

Powder coated steel racking with composite storage bins positioned evenly on both sides. Mounted on heavy-duty castors (two lockable) for mobility.

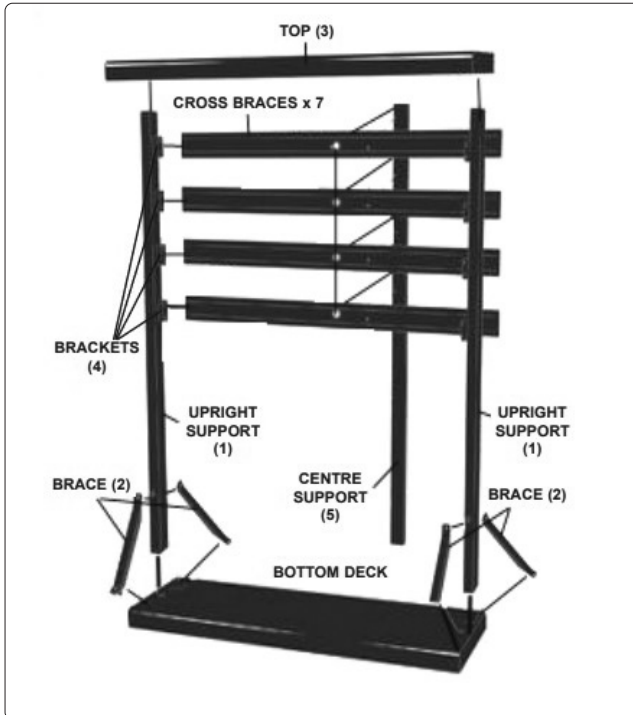
3. SPECIFICATION

4. ASSEMBLY

- 4.1. Attach castors x 4 to the underside of the bottom deck.
- 4.2. Attach upright supports (1) to bottom deck.
- 4.3. Connect brace supports (2) to upright supports (1) and bottom deck.
- 4.4. Attach top (3) to uprights (1).
- 4.5. Attach cross braces x 7 (only 4 shown on diagram) to the upright support brackets (4).
NOTE Ensure all centre support holes on the cross braces are in alignment with each other.
- 4.6. Attach centre support (5) to cross braces.
- 4.7. Ensure all fixings are secure.
