Suitable for removal / installation of the front lower control arm suspension bush on a Ford Transit (00 - 2014). The tool is designed to be used in conjunction with a press.



4. OPERATION

- 4.1. Ensure vertical alignment of the tool parts, the axis of the bush to be removed / fitted and the axis of the press to be used prior to attempting removal / fitting. Failure to do so may prevent correct operation.
- 4.2. Arrange the receiving cup so that the slotted area is facing towards the user. (See Fig 1).
